

Awards

(Revision March 1997)

- ◆ Awards are granted by the Awards Committee, acting on behalf of the National Executive Board.
- ◆ The Awards Committee meet about six times a year and consider Merit, Long Service and Honour Nominations from Units, Regional or National sources.
- ◆ All Unit and Regional nominations **must be signed** by the Regional Commissioner.
- ◆ The Order of the Silver Wolfhound is granted at the sole discretion of the Chief Scout.

The Long Service Awards are as follows:

Bronze Star for 10 years adult service	Gold Star with Bar for 40 years adult service
Silver Star for 20 years adult service	Golden Jubilee Medal for 50 years adult service
Gold Star for 30 years adult service	Golden Jubilee with Bar for 60 years adult service

Add a further Bar for each 10 years adult service.

Merit Awards are as follows:

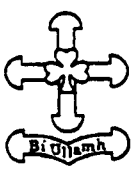
- Certificate:** For sustained service above the normal standard or for short-term service of exceptional character.
- Bronze:** Sustained service of an exceptional character, which has been exemplary at Unit level. affecting the Association beneficially at National level.
- Silver:** Most exceptional and notable service beneficially affecting other Units at local level.
- Gold:** For Leadership of the most inspiring kind at local or National level and of a most meritorious character.
- Bar:** A Bar to the Bronze. Silver or Gold Merit Medals may be granted when circumstances warrant it.
- Founders Award:** For profound service to the Association over a sustained period.
(The Founders Award should be presented by the Chief Scout or personal representative)

Honour Awards are as follows:

(For Service under difficult conditions. For bravery or service under suffering)

- Certificate:** For taking an active part in rescue operations.
- Bronze:** For rescue operations in hazardous conditions not necessarily involving danger to life.
- Silver:** For saving human life at personal risk to the rescuer's life.
- Gold:** For saving human life at extreme risk to the life of the rescuer.
(May be awarded posthumously)

- ◆ Merit and Honour Awards nominations should not stipulate a particular category being sought.
- ◆ Consideration should be given periodically to all adult personnel at Unit and Regional level deserving of Awards.
- ◆ Apply in good time, allowing about three months if possible.
- ◆ Awards should be presented on an appropriate occasion, with due ceremonial by the senior person present.
- ◆ Please ensure that Medals are inscribed with the recipient's name and all Certificates are framed before presentation.

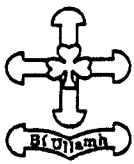

NOMINATION FOR LONG SERVICE AWARD

1. The Long Service Award is granted by the National Awards Committee to members who have given at least 10 years faithful and efficient service as a Scouter or Committee member.
2. The 10 or more years qualifying period of Service need not have been consecutive or wholly in the same rank. Service, as a Scout or in any other capacity than that mentioned above, cannot be counted.
3. Service Award is independent of the awards for meritorious service.
4. Service Awards are granted as follows : Bronze 10 years adult service - Silver 20 years adult service - Gold 30 years adult service.
